May be taken in any order, though generally after most essential major courses and University Core requirements have been completed; see Notes.

NOTES

*The number of required electives can vary according to other chosen courses (e.g., satisfying multiple requirements with a single course, credit disparities in language or science sequences, etc.).

** MUS 201M/201N and MUS 246 and 247 are not required for Jazz majors whose primary instrument is piano.
